1. Call to Order & Roll Call

PSEAC Chair called the meeting to order at 6:33pm

PRESENT: Chair Shelby Staffenson, Vice-Chair Carol Allen, Victoria Rizzo, Woodrow Terrell, Twilla Harrington, Mary Howell, Sheri Winters, and Robbie Cantrell.

ABSENT: None.

STAFF: Captain Doug Asboe.

GUESTS: None.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

The committee recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Public Comment on Non-Agenda Items

Paul Wilcox submitted a question via email for Captain Asboe. He wanted to know how many citations were issued for illegal fireworks.

4. Review of Monthly Law Enforcement Reports from August

Captain Asboe reviewed the August reports. The main thing that stood out from the calls for service log is the bank burglary. Our detectives assisted with that investigation as well as the FBI.

5. Follow up on the safety survey request to the City Council

Shelby Staffenson stated that she followed up with Erika Palmer on the First Friday details. She has it set up so we have a tent, a table, the giant QR code, and a box of all the things that we need. We will be set up in front of City Hall.

Sheri Winters asked if the results will include all of the written out comments?

Robbie Cantrell replied yes they will be included. I could also create a spreadsheet that will be automatically update as surveys are submitted. Should I set that up?

The Committee agreed.

The PSEAC booth at First Friday will be staffed by Twilla, Carol, and Woodrow.

Shelby Staffenson stated when she presented the survey to City Council, they were very in favor of it and approved us to spend up to \$500 to complete it. We will follow up on this at the October to see how it went and discuss next steps on promoting it.

Sheri Winters stated that the City Council was interested in the open-ended responses.

6. Discussion on National Night Out

Victoria Rizzo stated that she attended 6 National Night Outs: Wood Village, Rockwood, Oregon City, Happy Valley, Gresham, Sandy, and Maywood Park. There was food (some was free and some you had to buy), kids activities, disaster planning, informal surveys, fire trucks, police cars, ambulances, music, free haircuts, free massages, cadets, Sheriff's drone, a dunk tank, rock climbing, and several more activities and groups in attendance. I really hope that we will be able to do this next year. Maybe it can be coincided with the last movie in the parks night. We could possibly have Verizon attend to hand out back to school backpacks. The thing that I liked was a scavenger hunt for kids to do.

Carol Allen said that she attended the Oregon City Night Out. The only thing that I did like was that the music was so loud that you couldn't talk with the people in the booths. I talked to people about Neighborhood Watch and CERT (Certified Emergency Response Team) programs.

Woodrow Terrell stated that there have been a few conversations with the Boy Scouts about community night out and September being emergency preparedness month. There are quite a few people that believe Scouts should own Be Prepared and Preparedness month. We've take steps to focus on that. We've talked about how Night Out doesn't lend itself to the Scouts at the organic level but it does at the district level. We've discussed with the District Executives at how Scouting can be a part of the Night Out. We could bring in the Venture Crews, the Explorer Posts, and probably Scout Troops. Scouts want to be a part of this.

Twillia Harrington suggested at a future meeting to put together a timeline of what would need to be done over the next year to get to a place to make this happen.

Sheri Winters stated that she attended the Wood Village Night Out. When we are talking about all of this, what is our actual goal for the Night Out? Is it safety or community gathering? They had a Parkinsons group and in home aging group. There were some health care booths, info on sex trafficking, gardening stuff. I think we could focus too much and too many things. And with too many things will it really draw in the people. I felt like it was for law enforcement, safety, and brining community together. There must be something more to it than I realized.

The Committee discussed having it at Columbia Park and not an official Night Out but similar to a Night Out. It was preferred to have it on it's own weekday in late afternoon/early evening and separate from Movies in the Park.

Twillia Harrington asked if maybe this should be brought to the City Council for support and ask about creating a subcommittee with members of this group, the City, law enforcement and other to start working on this.

Woodrow Terrell stated an even like this usually has a small group of leaders focused on the vision and then a working group of people managing subcommittees for all of the individual areas of the event. And super important is to have one person in charge on the day of the event that is not on one of the subcommittees.

Shelby Staffenson asked the Committee to gather as much information on this as you can so we can discuss this some more at the next meeting so we can make some concrete decisions. It may take too long if we go before City Council but maybe I could just meet with Ray about it.

7. Review Committee's Goals

Shelby Staffenson reviewed the Committee Goals (in the August 1st meeting packet).

Sheri and Woodrow wondered if these goals were the most current goals?

Twillia Harrington stated that there was a Committee mission statement prepared. And since so much time has passed, they may not be still applicable goals. Maybe we could do a round robin to say what our goals would be today.

The Committee decided that a lot of these goals are being worked on currently, are outdated or are out of their control. They would be working on creating a new set of Committee Goals. The Committee is asked to come to the next meeting with goals to add to a new list of goals.

Captain Asboe stated historically this committee's goals have been too broad and not measurable and not time limit. When you think about goals, think about goals that have those aspects. And they are also specific enough that you will know what the outcome is. Just collecting data without a plan on what to do with the data is just taking up your time.

Sheri Winters stated that it's been brought to her attention that 257th has overgrown areas and it's hard to walk on the sidewalks. Is Multnomah County doing anything for this road? They are finalizing for the winter 2024-25 project. Also road sweeping issues on 257th, the old highway, and down by I-84 underpasses.

Woodrow Terrell stated great meeting.

Carol Allen stated it was a great meeting and looking forward to what happens next month.

Victoria Rizzo stated I wanted to clear up a misunderstanding from the end of the last meeting regarding fire fees. I don't remember saying that Troutdale was billed for them but Troutdale does pay for them.

11. Adjournment

MOTION: Sheri Winters moved to adjourn. Seconded by Twilla Harrington.

1. Call to Order & Roll Call

PSEAC Chair called the meeting to order at 6:32pm

PRESENT: Chair Shelby Staffenson, Victoria Rizzo, Twilla Harrington, Mary Howell, Sheri Winters, and Robbie Cantrell.

ABSENT: Vice-Chair Carol Allen (excused) and Woodrow Terrell (excused)

STAFF: Captain Steve Bevens; Lieutenant Jennifer Ciobanasiu; and Deputy Nick Bohrer.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

The Committee recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Public Comment on non-agenda items

None.

4. Approval of August 1, 2024 meeting minutes

Shelby Staffenson noted a correction, the guest listed as Linda Mann was actually her and that can be removed.

MOTION: Sheri Winters moved to adjourn. Seconded by Twilla Harrington.

Motion passed unanimously.

5. Review of Monthly Law Enforcement Reports from September

Captain Bevens introduced Jennifer Ciobanasiu who will be discussing the MCSO Drone Program.

Lieutenant Jennifer Ciobanasiu, River Patrol and Civil Unit, talked with the group about the Drone Program that she has been working on. This project started about 5 years ago and it's taken a long time to get it approved and finding the right system. The initial purchase would be for 6 drones, 2 can detect body heat, 2 have excellent cameras, and 2 are smaller drones for building searches. We will still have the plane but we will save money on fuel by using the drones and they can get much closer to the ground. We currently have 4 certified drone operators. There are worries from people that their privacy will be invaded. We will follow all the rules and laws that we already abide by with the airplane

Twilla Harrington stated that she was very excited about this. I have noticed sometimes when police are called out that a nosey neighbor will put up a drone. Will there be ways for the team to clear that air space?

Lieutenant Ciobanasiu replied the smaller drones are probably not going to get as high as ours. If we can get to see who is flying the drone we can have a conversation with them.

Shelby Staffenson asked how long does it take to get skilled in flying them?

Lieutenant Ciobanasiu replied some people said it was one of the hardest tests they've ever taken. There is extensive training that we are hoping to team up with Gresham Police and have them help us train. We are one of the last major agencies in the State that hasn't purchased drones yet.

Mary Howell asked are those tests done through the FAA?

Lieutenant Ciobanasiu replied yes they are FAA certified and get a license.

Captain Bevins reviewed the August reports and discussed some thing that the City Manager would like to see:

- More tickets written and less warnings
- Utilizing Municipal Court
- Slowing the speeding along Columbia River Highway due to the Stark Street Bridge closure
- A site visit out to Thousand Acres with State Lands, Ray Young, and an incoming County Commissioner to assess the situation out there

Shelby Staffenson said that she wanted to follow up on a public inquiry from last month by Paul Wilcox asking for how many citations were issued for illegal fireworks in Troutdale.

Captain Bevins replied that this had not been passed on to him and if he had known earlier in the day he could have gotten info from the County analysts. He would guess that it was very low.

Shelby Staffenson stated that Carol Allen had noticed on Facebook and Nextdoor, a number of posts about Police Officers in cars not doing anything when there is speeding on 257th and Troutdale Road. One person said they talked with an Officer who did nothing and they were very frustrated. Is there some threshold before something happens on traffic related things?

The Committee discussed deploying the box speed data collector for areas that they are hearing about speeding complaints. If it is found that there is a speeding problem, Captain Bevins would be able to assign Deputy Bohrer to work in that area.

Victoria Rizzo stated you probably want to monitor the City of Troutdale's Facebook page. There was a big post about Sunrise Park and they are removing the port-a-potty because it's continuously vandalized. There were lots of comments with several about the police and them not doing anything.

6. Follow up on the safety survey at First Friday and next steps

Twillia Harrington stated that the event went really well. There were quite a few people that took the online survey. Feedback for the next time that we do it is that it would be really great to have a quarter sheet with the QR code printed on it because people wanted to walk away and take the survey somewhere else more comfortably. The other thing that came up was there were quite a few other surveys going on and people were very confused about the difference. I believe Parks or Metro had one, there was another one, and people weren't sure what they were giving feedback on. They were also not wanting to complete multiple surveys. Overall, it was great to talk to the Community. I didn't have any complaints. Most people were very positive about the state of Troutdale and how things are going. It will be interesting to see the online data and see if there are any trends or comments.

Robbie Cantrell stated there were 21 online response and a few paper copies were received but those have not been entered yet. There are some noticeable trends:

- 45% were within region D (east Troutdale)
- 57% knew there was a Public Safety Committee
- 65% would attend a public safety meeting
- Most, if not all, were at least somewhat satisfied with the police services
- 55% said they were satisfied with the fire department services
- Most people didn't have a strong opinion for emergency medical services
- Level of communication between the police department and the community was relatively good
- 60% people feel safe walking alone in their neighborhood
- People feel relatively safe in public spaces such as parks or shopping areas
- Not many people are concerned about violent crimes, 7 people were not concerned at all but 4 said they are really concerned about violent crime
- Property crime was all across the board from 1's to 5's
- Not a lot of people concerned about gang activity
- In the additional comment fields, a lot of them were concerning drug use and drug related crime
- People view police interaction within diverse communities pretty positively
- People believe the police are visible and accessible in the community
- Other comments were regarding poverty, lack of living wages, mental health, houselessness, not enough enforcement, and lack of police.
- Traffic related concerns included red lights being ran, speeding, accidents or near misses, and the amount of U-turns at the intersection of 257th and Columbia River Highway
- 63% were interested in emergency and disaster preparedness

The committee wanted to get the survey link to City staff and have them put it on the water bills, Troutdale's website homepage, and the social media pages. They were also interested in printing the QR code on paper to hand out to apartments and other locations where residents don't get individual water bills and having some available at City Hall. Committee members will also go to other Committee meetings to promote the survey and talk about it to their neighbors as well.

The Committee wanted to make the following updates to the survey:

- Add some street names to the border lines of the different sections on the map so it is more clear
- Adding a box on the gang question to specify “if so, where” they are concerned about gang activity

The group wanted to get the survey out in November and collect responses up until their January meeting. At that meeting or no later than the February meeting, analyze the results and see if there is anything to bring to the Public Safety Working Group. Also, it was mentioned that the results should be presented to the Council since they did approve this.

7. Discussion on National Night Out

Victoria Rizzo stated to get started, the most important things to decide on would be a date, time and venue. Before the end of the year she will prepare a check list for tracking. Also work on food donation requests now for hamburgers or hotdogs from somewhere like Fred Meyer or Costco so they can plan on that for when we would need it. We would then work on vendors.

Shelby Staffenson stated that she spoke with Marlee and she thought we should consult the special events manual because we will need to apply for permits which may trigger other permits. I think we should propose that the City sponsor this event and not the Committee. With our Committee membership potentially changing in July, it might not make sense to try to do an event in August or September. It will take all of us to do a good event. Maybe the event should take place in June?

Sheri Winters suggested that maybe other Committees could be involved with this as well so it's not just PSEAC.

The Committee decided that since not all members were present that they should bring this item back at a future meeting when everyone is present. The Committee was also very interested in approaching Fairview or maybe Wood Village to team up and do a joint Night Out for the first one.

8. Define Committee's Goals

Victoria Rizzo stated that she had a short term goal from Parks. The Imagination Station matting is in really bad shape and they can't get the budget to get it fixed properly. Could the Committee present a letter to City Council saying it's a great concern for the people that go there? The Parks Department is doing their best to patch it but it needs a good overhaul. The other 2 big goals are getting a CERT program started which would require a sponsor and then contacting CERT to get some instructors. The other thing is getting the Cadet and Explorers going again for the kids with some promotion. Woodrow is already working on this.

Twillia Harrington stated with the new Councilors coming in, it would be good to get in front of them and do a presentation and share some of the work we've done and see if they have any items to task us with.

Mary Howell stated she thinks CERT is a good idea and may entail a lot of work but would be doable. She also liked Victoria's goal regarding the matting at Imagination Station.

Sheri Winters stated the survey, public input at their meetings, and CERT training. She agreed that the matting at Imagination Station does need to be repaired but we found out that it is really \$100,000 that they have to work with in this budget.

Twillia Harrington told the Committee that there is a Disaster Preparedness seminar on the calendar of events on November 20th. It's a free event, you just need to register on the City's website, and maybe express the need for more training.

The Committee will be bringing their top goals to the next meeting where they will put together a final list of goals.

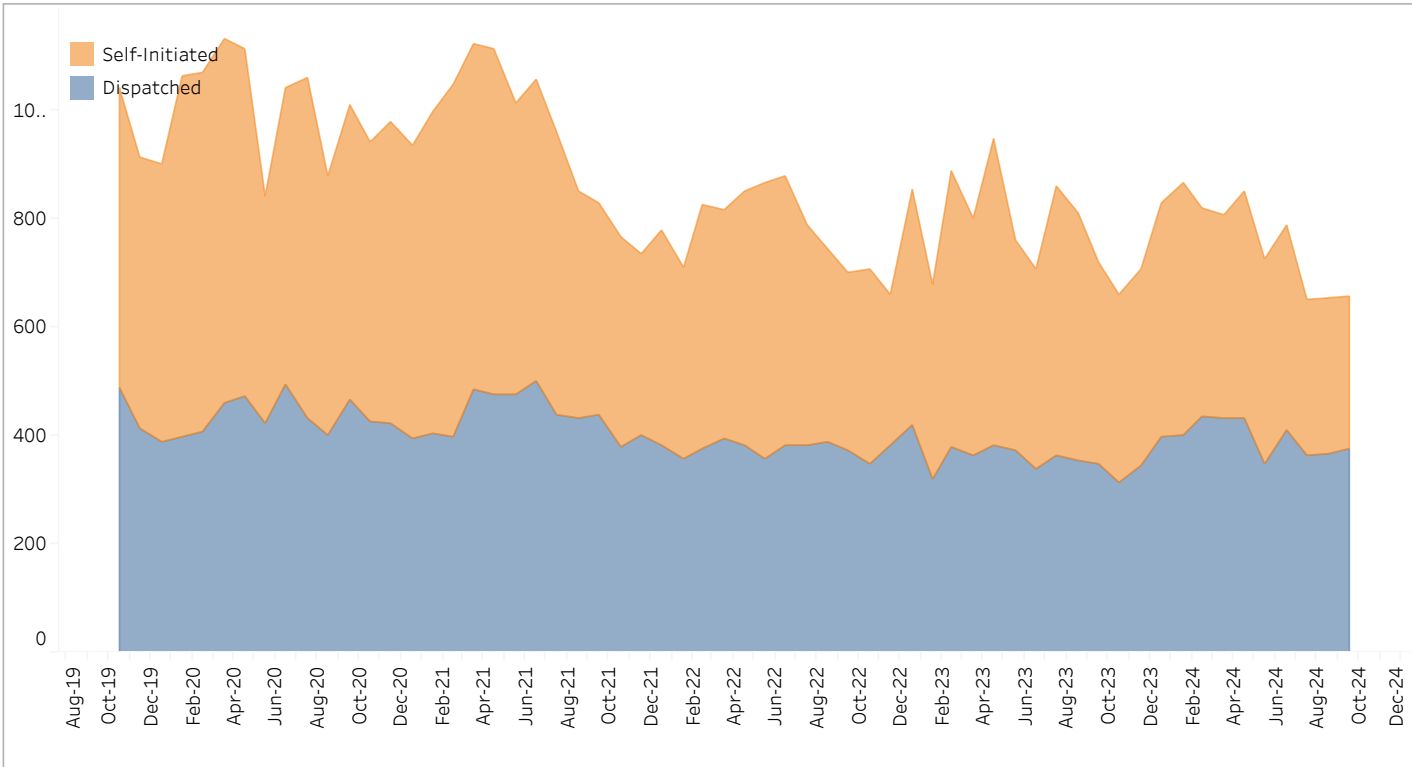

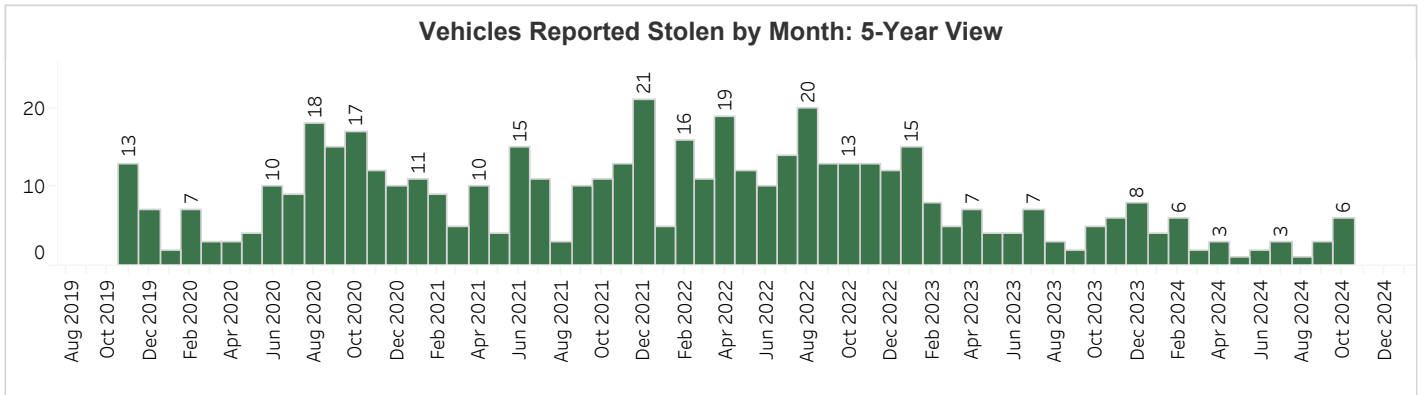

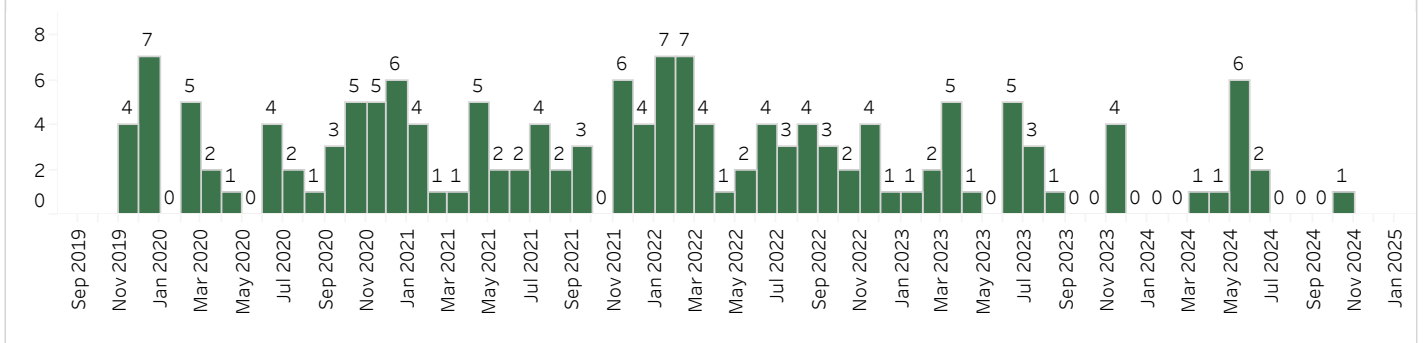
